<b>Appliances</b>	We accept appliances less than 15 years old, including: <b>washing machines, dryers, refrigerators, microwave ovens, electric ranges, and freezers.</b> Appliances must be in perfect working condition and have all necessary parts. Please call ahead regarding appliances older than 15 years old that are in exceptional condition. EPA regulations prevent the resale of water heaters, refrigerators and dishwashers that do not meet lead-free certifications.
<b>Cabinets</b>	We accept residential and commercial cabinets. Cabinets must have all drawers and be completely free from water damage, mold, or structural damage. Additionally, we accept solid wood cabinet doors in usable condition.
<b>Doors</b>	We accept pre-hung, interior, exterior, commercial, antique, and storm doors. Doors should be free from rotten wood, broken panels, or punctures. With the exception of antique doors, there must be no cracked or broken glass. Storm doors must have all necessary tracking.
<b>Flooring</b>	We accept new carpets – in all sizes exceeding 25 sq. ft. and new or used rugs of any size. All carpets and rugs must be in good condition with no stains, fraying, odors, or animal hair. Hardwood, vinyl, & laminate flooring should be donated in quantities of 40 sq. ft. or larger. Tile flooring needs to be in its original packaging: -12”X12” or larger – 25 sq. ft. or more -Sizes between 2”X2” and 12”X 12” – 10 sq. ft. or more -Mosaic or smaller than 2” X 2” – in any quantity
<b>Furniture</b>	We accept upholstered furniture without stains, rips, or animal hair, as well as all wood or metal furniture that is structurally sound. We do NOT accept furniture from smoking homes. We do accept mattresses and box springs that are free of stains, smells and bed bugs. Large desks are accepted on a case by case basis. Please call ahead. No pianos.
<b>Hardware</b>	We accept door hardware, hinges, nails, screws, bolts, brackets, fasteners, and all tools (hand and power) that are in working order and pose no safety risk. Because of disposal issues, we cannot take lithium or NiCS batteries unable to hold a charge.
<b>Home Décor</b>	We accept pictures, pottery, art work, dish sets & more!
<b>Lawn and Garden</b>	We accept metal patio furniture, yard tools, and <b>unopened</b> yard care products such as grass seed and fertilizers. We also accept small engine tools such as weed-eaters, lawn mowers, hedge trimmers, and tillers, provided they are in perfect working condition and entirely emptied of fuel. Fire regulations prevent our acceptance of any engine or motor containing fuel.

<b>Electrical</b>	We accept commercial and residential electrical supplies, including switches, outlets, drop cords, coaxial cable, and various electrical wiring of usable length and gauge.
<b>Lighting</b>	We accept indoor and outdoor lamps and hard wired light fixtures provided they are in working order and without broken panes of glass or cracked globes. We accept track lighting and recessed lighting for both resale and scrap metal purposes.
<b>Lumber/Trim</b>	We accept sheet goods (drywall, plywood, pegboard, OSB, etc.) in pieces of ¼ of a sheet size or larger. Pieces of siding, trim, molding, and lumber must be at least 48 in. or longer. There must be no rot, water damage, nails or warping.
<b>Paint/Adhesives</b>	We accept containers of paint (50% full or more), spray paint, primer, and stain, less than 5 years old, provided that the product has been stored indoors in a temperature controlled environment, with no external rust or dirt around the lid.
<b>Plumbing</b>	We accept all sinks complete with the necessary mounting brackets and pedestals. We accept plumbing hardware, low-flow toilets, tubs, and faucets meeting new EPA lead-free requirement certifications. Jacuzzi tubs must be in full working-order.
<b>Windows</b>	We accept both complete wooden and complete vinyl windows, provided there is no cracked glass, fogged glass, or broken panes. There must be no rot or water damage on the frame. Wooden and vinyl window sashes are accepted independent of original framing if they are in excellent shape and can be repurposed.
